1. Bull calf, born after August 31, 2009 and over 4 months of age.
2. Yearling bull, born after August 31, 2008 and before September 1, 2009
3. Champion Bull, winners of Class 1 and 2
4. Heifer Calf, born after August 31, 2009 and over 4 months of age
5. Junior Yearling Heifer, born between March 1 and August 31, 2009
6. Senior Yearling Heifer, born between Sept 1, 2008 and Feb 28, 2009
7. Junior Champion Female, Winners of classes 4,5 and 6 - rosette
8. Reserve Junior Champion Female, except Junior Champion, winners of classes 4,5 and 6 and second place winner in Junior Champion's Open Single class-Rosette
9. Junior Get-of-Sire, group to consist of 4 animals under 2 two(2) years of age, none of which has freshened; either sex, the get-of-one sire; not more than two(2) can be bulls. Sire must be named and each exhibitor is limited to one entry sired by the same bull. At least three(3) animals must have been bred by exhibitor. Animals may be owned by one or more exhibitors.

3. Entries must be in place by 11:00 a.m. Thursday
4. Judging on Thursday following the 4-H show, approximately 6:00 p.m.
5. Release time is 5:00 p.m. Sunday
6. An exhibitor may receive only two premiums in any individual lot.
7. Sheep must be owned by the exhibitor from time of making entries
8. All animals must be recorded to be eligible to show.
9. An animal owned in partnership may be entered in one partner's name in all classes to which it is eligible, but must be shown under but one ownership throughout the classifications of the fair, and the entry must carry a footnote showing the actual ownership as it appears in the Breed Flock Book.
10. All sheep originating outside of Minnesota must be accompanied by approved Health Certificates from the state of origin.
11. All sheep one year or over, to be eligible to show, must have been shown within the calendar year.
12. Other general livestock exhibitor rules as found in the Fair premium list will apply.
13. The base date for computing age will be September 1. Yearling..born before September 1 of the previous year

1. Exhibitors under 20 years of age are eligible to enter this show.
2. Entries must be in place by 4:00 p.m. Saturday, August 14th.
3. All entries release immediately following the show.
4. Exhibitors may enter 2 entries per lot.
5. Sheep must be owned by exhibitor at time of making entry.
6. All sheep originating outside of Minnesota must be accompanied by approved Health Certificates from state of origin.
7. Lambs entered must have been born on or after January 1, 2010
8. Five or more entries will be required for breed class lots.
9. Animals entered in Breed Class lots must be eligible for registration but need not be registered. Non-registerable animals will be entered in the commercial class.
10. Premium schedule-Premiums will be paid on a sliding scale determined by number of entries per lot:
